Entry Rules:

An award will be presented to winning members.

1. Applicants must be a member of Carolinas MBCEA.
2. The primary structure of each project must have as a minimum a pre-engineered structural system and a roof system in order to qualify.
3. Awards for Broken Spud will be presented for those projects worthy of special recognition.
4. To be eligible, buildings must have been completed between January 1, 2014 and April 1, 2015.
5. Judging will be conducted by a panel of experts who are not members of the chapter.
6. There is no charge for an entry.
7. Deadline for entries is **May 1, 2015**. All entries must be received on or before this date.
